

WELCOME TO HUSTHWAITE

Husthwaite is an ancient settlement, one of the oldest buildings being St. Nicholas' Parish Church dating from the twelfth century, which, with the Village Green, forms the centre of the village.

The village is a Designated Conservation Area and is adjacent to the North Yorkshire Moors National Park. Part of the parish is within the nationally designated Howardian Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

Husthwaite is fortunate to have a strong sense of community with a good range of local services.

PARISH CHURCH

St. Nicholas Parish Church, built in the 12th Century, is one of five churches forming a benefice served by Rev. Ian Kitchen. Weekly Services are held at various times on Sundays and information about these is available in 'The Link' – our Benefice magazine – and on the notice-board by the Church gate. St. Nicholas welcomes newcomers and coffee and biscuits are served after services so that people can meet and chat together.

Every Thursday, at 6.00p.m., there is a half-hour prayer meeting, enabling people to pray together informally.

Morning coffee is served at Husthwaite Church of England Primary School every Friday during term time from 8.30 – 9.30a.m.

HUSTHWAITE METHODIST CHURCH

The Methodist Church is situated opposite the Village Shop in High Street, a red brick building dating from 1928. There is a weekly service at 10.30a.m. on Sunday morning and details of preachers can be found on a notice on the gate-post.

Every third Saturday of the month, the Chapel is open to all members of the village community for Coffee and Chat. This is an opportunity to meet with friends old and new and enjoy free coffee, biscuits and informal chat. On the first Wednesday of each month there is a prayer meeting, open to all, from 9.00 – 9.30a.m. There is a box in the Chapel porch for Prayer Requests and the Chapel is left open until 4.00p.m. on Sundays for anyone to enjoy a few moments of quiet and to leave any requests for prayers for individuals or any general concerns.

There is a Soup 'n' Pud Lunch on the second Wednesday of September, November, January, March and May. This is available to anyone in the village and is another opportunity for meeting together. During the Autumn and Spring terms, there is a fortnightly Bible Study which is held in different homes.

REFUSE COLLECTION AND RE-CYCLING

Collections of household and garden waste take place on Mondays. Black bins for household waste and Green bins for garden waste are collected on alternate weeks.

Blue Plastic Boxes are provided for glass, plastic bottles and tins/cans and Blue Plastic Bags for newspapers and magazines. These are emptied as detailed in the calendar provided by Hambleton District Council.
